- 83rd Members' Meeting presented by Audrain Motorsport will take place on 18 and 19 April with tickets already on sale to the Goodwood Road Racing Club.
- Festival of Speed presented by Mastercard will take place from 9 - 12 July.
- Goodwood Revival will take place from 18 - 20 September.

The 2026 motorsport season begins over the weekend of 18-19 April with the 83<sup>rd</sup> Members' Meeting presented by Audrain Motorsport, exclusive to the Goodwood Road Racing Club (GRRC). As the grand finale to the Goodwood motorsport season, the Goodwood Revival is an unmissable celebration of motor racing's golden age. Set against the backdrop of the Goodwood Motor Circuit's heyday (1948–1966), it brings together breathtaking classic cars, magnificent post-war aircraft, live music, and vintage fashion for a truly immersive experience. The 2025 Goodwood Revival paid a heartfelt tribute to Jim Clark, celebrating his remarkable life both on and off the track - with a memorable moment that saw the Pit Straight filled with sheep to honour his farming roots. The event also marked key milestones such as the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Volkswagen Type 2 Split Screen, which included a one-of-a-kind livery created by American artist Daniel Arsham.

From start to finish, Goodwood's 2026 motorsport season promises speed, style, and history - celebrating the passion and innovation that define the world of motorsport and the automotive industry.
