The very first Goodwood Festival of Speed took place in 1993 and was the brainchild of The Duke of Richmond, then Lord March. The event centered around the hillclimb running through the parklands of Goodwood House. The idea was received enthusiastically by the late Robert Brooks, racing driver turned auctioneer, who later went on to acquire Bonhams in 2000.

The inaugural Goodwood Festival of Speed in 1993 was a resounding success, striking a chord with the public and igniting a passion for motorsport that continues to resonate to this day. The Festival's rapid growth enabled The Duke to renovate the historic Goodwood Motor Circuit which had been opened by his racing driver grandfather – Freddie March – in 1948 and was in operation until 1966.

In 1998 the first Goodwood Revival – celebrating the years during which the Goodwood Motor Circuit was operational – was staged, with a Bonhams sale mirroring the success of the Festival of Speed. More recently in 2014, Goodwood introduced the Members' Meeting, which has featured a Bonhams|Cars auction since 2015.

Together, The Duke of Richmond and Robert Brooks laid the foundation for what would become some of the most celebrated motorsport events in the world. Their shared passion shaped the format and identity of Goodwood's events, creating a legacy that continues to captivate automotive enthusiasts worldwide.
